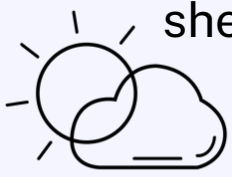
## 1 IMMEDIATE CARE

After delivery make sure you water your plant until the soil is moist then check over the plant to make sure it is in good condition.



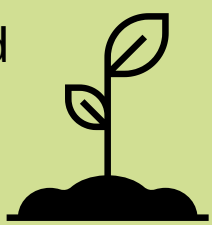
## POSITION 2

- **Soil Conditions:** Any non-waterlogged soil (for best results use sandy and slightly acidic soil)
- **Light:** Full sun to partial shade is ideal
- **Location:** Although these are hardy, a partially sheltered position is recommended



## 3 PLANTING

It is important that you remove the plant from its nursery pot, so plant in a container or in the ground as soon as possible.



## ESTABLISHING 4

Water in small amounts regularly for the first three weeks. The soil should only be moist at all times, we recommend watering close to the base of the plant instead of at the top.



## 5 CARING

- Only prune in dormant season
- Re-pot potted acers every 2-3 years
- Apply slow release fertiliser every spring
- In winter wrap pot in bubble wrap to protect from frost
