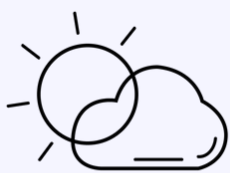
1 IMMEDIATE CARE

Plant straight after delivery. If you are unable to do so, place in a cool, dark location until ready to plant.



POSITION 2

- **Soil:** Well-drained soil
- **Position:** Full sun
- **Flowering:** Late spring and early summer



3 PLANTING



Dig holes in the flower bed that are three times the size of the bulb itself, and place the bulbs in the holes with the pointy end facing upwards

ESTABLISHING 4

Water the plants in small amounts regularly until established. The soil should be moist at all times, we recommend watering close to the base to ensure the roots are getting the needed water.



5 CARING



- Cut back alliums at the end of the blooming season
- Remove any dead foliage in early summer
- If the stem turns brown and hollow, detach the stem at the base
- Monitor for any signs of diseased foliage
