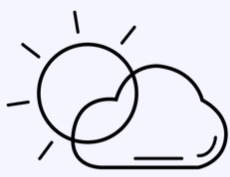
1 IMMEDIATE CARE

Upon receipt of your plants, carefully remove them from the postal packaging. The root ball should be moist, if the plants appear to be dry stand them in a saucer of water for a few minutes until moist.

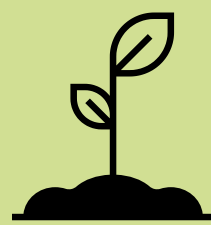


POSITION 2

- **Position:** Full sun or dappled shade with shelter
- **Soil:** Moist acidic, well-drained soil



3 PLANTING



Plant in garden or container with well prepared weed free soil containing plenty of organic matter such as compost. Add a fertiliser and soil-conditioning product, following the manufacturers instructions. Make a planting hole large enough to take the plant's root ball and incorporate compost with the soil removed, use this soil when backfilling the hole around the plant.

ESTABLISHING 4

Water the plants in small amounts regularly until established. The soil should be moist at all times, we recommend watering close to the base to ensure the roots are getting the needed water.



5 CARING



- Use a balanced fertiliser throughout the growing season from spring to late August.
- Frequently remove unwanted canes at ground level
