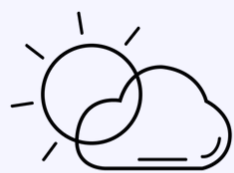
1 IMMEDIATE CARE

After delivery make sure you remove the bulbs from the box. If not planting immediately, store in a dry and cool room until you are ready to plant them.



POSITION 2

- **Soil:** Acidic to neutral, well drained soil
- **Position:** Sheltered spot with plenty of sun
- **Planting:** These can be grown in the ground, container or hanging pots



3 PLANTING



Dig a hole 2-3 times the depth of the bulb with a 15-20 cm planting distance between each hole. Place the bulb in the hole with the pointed tip facing upwards and cover the bulb with the soil.

ESTABLISHING 4

Water the plants in small amounts regularly until established. The soil should be moist at all times, we recommend watering close to the base to ensure the roots are getting the needed water.



5 CARING



- If naturalised in grass, do not cut the grass until the flowers have died and leaves have yellowed.
- Don't trim leaves on spring crocuses until completely yellow
