



# FRITILLARIA

## 1 IMMEDIATE CARE

Plant straight after delivery. If you are unable to do so, place in a cool, dark location until ready to plant.



## POSITION 2

- **Soil:** Well-drained soil / moisture-retentive
- **Position:** Full sun, partial shade
- **Planting:** Plant in Autumn

(Positioning is subject to type of Fritillaria, check for specific requirements)



## 3 PLANTING



Dig holes in the flower bed that are three times the size of the bulb itself, and place the bulbs in the holes with the pointy end facing upwards

## ESTABLISHING 4

Water the plants in small amounts regularly until established. The soil should be moist at all times, we recommend watering close to the base to ensure the roots are getting the needed water.



## 5 CARING



- Allow foliage to die completely after flowering
- For larger fritillary, apply mulch and tomato fertiliser in spring
