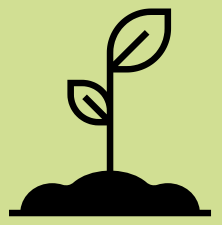
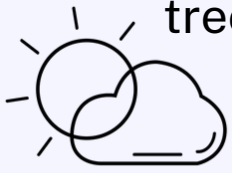
1 IMMEDIATE CARE

After delivery make sure you water your plant until the soil is moist then check over the plant to make sure it is in good condition.



POSITION 2

- **Distance:** We recommend a planting distance of up to 8ft, if planting closer together ensure you prune more frequently
- **Position:** This will be different depending on type of tree, make sure you research for your tree type



3 PLANTING

First, dig a hole 30cm deep and 60cm wide. Make sure the graft mark is above the soil when planting. Add a stake vertically with 80cm above ground level. Place the tree in the hole 5-10cm from the stake. Mix 50% compost and 50% topsoil and fill the hole. Water well once planted.

ESTABLISHING 4

Water the plants in small amounts regularly until established. The soil should be moist at all times, we recommend watering close to the base to ensure the roots are getting the needed water.



5 CARING

- Regularly check rubber ties to see if it needs loosening
- Check stake is secure after stormy weather
- Feed with a good quality fruit tree fertiliser as directed on fertiliser instructions
