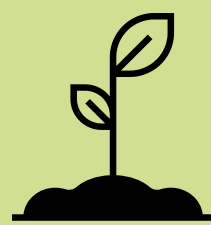
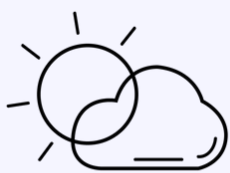
## 1 IMMEDIATE CARE

After delivery make sure you water your plant until the soil is moist then check over the plant to make sure it is in good condition.



## POSITION 2

- **Soil:** Rich well drained soil is best
- **Position:** Full sun if possible, but will still grow happily in lightly shaded areas
- **Note:** Try not to plant too closely together, have a gap if possible



## 3 PLANTING

It is important that you remove the plant from its nursery pot, so plant in a container or in the ground as soon as possible.

## ESTABLISHING 4

Water the plants in small amounts regularly until established. The soil should be moist at all times, we recommend watering close to the base to ensure the roots are getting the needed water.



## 5 CARING

- Apply a general-purpose fertiliser each year in spring, then add a layer of compost to conserve moisture
- As they grow taller, use a stake to support the stems with large flower heads
