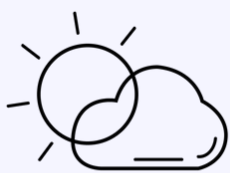
1 IMMEDIATE CARE

Plant straight after delivery. If you are unable to do so, place in a cool, dark location until ready to plant.

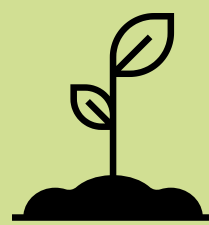


POSITION 2

- **Soil:** Loose sandy soil
- **Position:** Full sun, but will tolerate light shade
- **Planting:** Perfect for containers, borders or naturalised in lawns



3 PLANTING



Dig a 20cm hole and place the bulb inside with the pointy end facing upwards. Then cover the bulb with the excess soil you just dug up. These bulbs should be planted around 5-10 cm apart.

ESTABLISHING 4

Water the plants in small amounts regularly until established. The soil should be moist at all times, we recommend watering close to the base to ensure the roots are getting the needed water.



5 CARING



- Deadhead after flowering
- Let foliage die down naturally
- Apply slow-release bulb fertiliser in spring
