## 1 IMMEDIATE CARE

After delivery make sure you water your plant until the soil is moist then check over the plant to make sure it is in good condition.



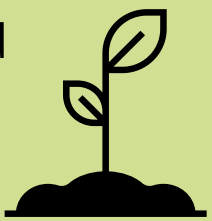
## POSITION 2

- **Soil Conditions:** Fertile, moist, well-drained soil
- **Location:** Sunny open area
- Plant grasses from cool climates in autumn
- Plant grasses from warm climates in late spring



## 3 PLANTING

It is important that you remove the plant from its nursery pot, so plant in a container or in the ground as soon as possible.



## ESTABLISHING 4

Water in small amounts regularly for the first three weeks. The soil should only be moist at all times, we recommend watering close to the base of the plant instead of at the top.



## 5 CARING

- Evergreen grasses should be tidied up by pulling old stems out of the plant but make sure to wear gloves as they can be sharp. Deciduous grasses should be cut back in early March.
