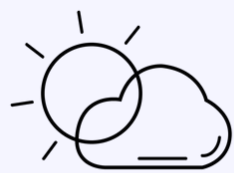
1 IMMEDIATE CARE

After delivery make sure you water your plant until the soil is moist then check over the plant to make sure it is in good condition.



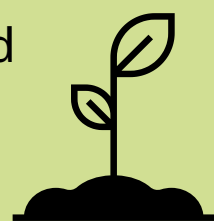
POSITION 2

- **Soil Conditions:** Well-drained chalk, clay, loam or sand
- **Light:** Full sun to partial shade is ideal
- **pH:** Most pH levels are ok, including acidic, alkaline and neutral



3 PLANTING

It is important that you remove the plant from its nursery pot, so plant in a container or in the ground as soon as possible unless directed otherwise.



ESTABLISHING 4

Water in small amounts regularly for the first three weeks. The soil should only be moist at all times, we recommend watering close to the base of the plant instead of at the top.



5 CARING

- Water regularly during dry periods in summer
- Feed with a general granular plant food in spring
- The best time to prune is in spring to optimise berry production
